### Instructions for Library BINGO!

- Complete the “task” in a square and cross it off. For each BINGO! (5 in a row or diagonal), you receive one ticket for the weekly sweepstakes, up to twelve tickets per card if you complete all the squares!
  
- There’s a new card & prize drawing each week. Dates are listed at the top of each card. **\*Don’t miss your chance to win- be sure to turn in your cards on time! Please be sure you’ve completed your contact info at the top of each card.\***
  - You can return your card to a librarian during our regular open hours.
  - You can put your completed card in an envelope & drop it in the book return.
  - You can send us an email at [n\\_salem@cwmares.org](mailto:n_salem@cwmares.org). Please put “BINGO” in the subject line and be sure to include your name, phone number, & how many BINGO! you completed.
  - We kindly ask that you **do not** leave a voice message with the information, as it can be very difficult for us to clearly hear the necessary details in a voice message.
  
- Have fun and explore your library!
  - “Read...” should be interpreted to include “listen to an audiobook” or “listen to someone read to me” or whatever works for you or your child.
  - “Find..” means just that – locate the item in the library, then cross off the square!
  - “Check out..” doesn’t mean you have to read the whole book. Take it home, give it a try for a few pages, and if you don’t like it, move on to something you’ll enjoy. We’re only encouraging you to explore. Life is short, read what you love!
  - On the Children/Youth/Teen cards, one reading “Time Block” is:
    - 10-15 minutes for pre-readers and early readers
    - 15-20 minutes for middle-level readers
    - 30-60 minutes for older Tweens and Teens
  
- Can’t find a book about space? Don’t know where the magazines are located? Ask a librarian!
  
- Please note that all prizes must be picked up in-person at the library.
