COMMUNITY INTERACTION (June):

- **Library visits: Adults = 251 / Teens = 8 / Children = 37 / Overall total = 296**
- Program attendance: "Investigating Insects!" had 10 (2 families and a single adult plus me). The 3 CNC "Quabbin StoryWalk" programs had a total attendance of 62. "Creating a Pollinator Garden" had 7 attending and the card-making program with Lynn Layton had 6 participants. The **total program attendance was 85.**
- Yoga class had 23 attendees.
- The Book Discussion Group had 7.
- Search Committee meetings in the library had a total attendance of 14.
- **Total # for all types of "attendance" = 425**

- **Circulation totals: June circulation = 650**
